

Rose Bank Pet Policy (August 2015)

Although we are Dog owners ourselves and Rose Bank is pet friendly, we do adopt a strict pet policy to protect our property and for the benefit and comfort of all guests who come to stay with us in the future.

- There is an additional pet fee of £10 per Dog per stay. A maximum of 2 well behaved dogs are allowed at any one time.
- We reserve the right to refuse any booking that we feel is not appropriate.
- Full details, including name and breed of Dog(s) must be given on the Booking form. On arrival at Rose Bank should the pets that you have brought with you not reflect those detailed on the booking form then we reserve the right to refuse occupation. In these circumstances the cost of your holiday will be refunded to you less your initial £100 deposit and your good housekeeping £100 deposit which will be kept by us to compensate for our loss of the booking.
- In consideration of our future guests pet owners are responsible for cleaning up and disposing of all pet refuse.
- For the consideration of our future guests at Rose Bank we request that pets
 are not allowed on furniture or in the bedrooms at any time. Any evidence of
 pets on furniture or bedding will incur extra cleaning costs, which we will deduct
 from your good housekeeping deposit.
- A plastic bath/jug can be found in the out house for bathing muddy/sandy pets
 so please ensure your pet is clean and dry before being allowed into the cottage.
 Please do not use the bath in the bathroom to clean your pet.
- Pets should be treated with a flea and tick repellent prior to arrival. The cost of dealing with any infestation caused by your pet/pets will be deducted from your good housekeeping deposit.
- Please keep pets under control when inside the cottage and do not leave pets unattended inside or outside the Holiday cottage. The cost of rectifying any damage caused by your pets to the interior or the fixtures and fittings of our holiday cottage will be deducted from your good housekeeping deposit.
- We assume no responsibility for illness or injury that may occur to your pet/pets whilst you are staying at the holiday cottage and details of the Academy Vets in Stranraer can be found inside the tourist information folder.
